RCom unit bags telecom deal

Mumbai, March 2

Reliance Globalcom, part of the Anil Ambani controlled Reliance Communications, has bagged a three-year contract with Rémy Cointreau Group to implement a new dedicated telecom network to support the distribution strategy of the Paris based conglomerate. Reliance Globalcom's services will cover geographical areas in Europe, the US and Asia to meet the new requirements of the group such as implementation of a new ERP applications, strong authentication services for remote users, Web filtering, anti-virus, and Voice over IP solutions. Reliance Globalcom's solutions would be implemented in 45 sites of the Remy Cointreau Group spread across 12 countries including France, the UK, Russia, the US, China, Japan and Vietnam, according to a press statement issued here on Monday. - **Our Bureau**
